

Dr. Maureen Leehey of The University of Colorado Denver in the Department of Neurology in collaboration with Dr. Randi Hagerman of the M.I.N.D. Institute at University of California Davis is recruiting subjects for two Fragile X-associated Tremor/Ataxia Syndrome (FXTAS) studies. The first study involves an evaluation that includes cognitive testing, review of family history, blood draw, neurological exam and MRI. The second study is a clinical drug trial evaluating the effect of a medication (memantine) on neurological symptoms of FXTAS. Persons that are a carrier of the gene that causes Fragile X Syndrome in families, *FMRI*, and are at least 30 years old may be able to participate. All testing and evaluations are free of charge and travel support may be available.
